

## Residential Shoreline Restoration Grant



Thank you for your interest in the Residential Shoreline Restoration Grant sponsored by the Huebner Fishery Management Foundation.

Attached you will find the application and requirements. **Please read all requirements thoroughly and complete the application fully before submitting.**

The Residential Shoreline Restoration Grant is a 1-year reimbursement program. The maximum limit of the grant is \$2,000.00\*, and allotment of the funds will be based on the number of accepted applications and the scope of each project.

\* \$200.00 of the grant allotment goes towards a shoreline assessment of the lake property with Integrated Lakes Management, Inc. (ILM) The consultation includes a one (1) hour consultation with the property owner and recommendation report.

The intent of the grant is to help residents restore the shoreline of Round Lake in an environmentally conscience manner that will in turn help to improve the quality of Round Lake and make it more sustainable for years to come.

The property owner is responsible for property locations and staking their property lines.

Those who are awarded the grant will need to meet with ILM prior to any work being done on the shoreline. Once the consultation and report is completed, the property owner may be required to meet with his/her respective village and other interested parties to ensure that any permits and /or environmental concerns are addressed prior to work being done.

Once all of the work is completed, grantee will be required to notify the Round Lake Area Park District (RLAPD). The RLAPD, or its representatives, will conduct a site visit to verify the work has been completed per the approved application. After the work has been reviewed and approved, and copies of all invoices and receipts have been turned in, applicant will receive the funds allotted from the approved application.

Grant may not be used to fund projects which have already been completed prior to application and approval of application.

## **Deadline for Applications is March 1, 2017**

### **Requirements for the Residential Shoreline Restoration Grant**

The following has been established to create a uniform standard for the Residential Shoreline Restoration Grant for Round Lake. Residents applying for the grant must follow these requirements.

General:

1. Residents applying for the grant must comply with all requirements of the program as well as any requirements by their village, local, state, and federal government regulations.
2. Residents who are awarded the grant must have a consultation with Integrated Lakes Management, Inc., and adhere to best recommended practices and steps provided in their report.
3. All work to be reimbursed by the grant must be completed by June 1, 2017. Any deadline extensions request must be made in writing no later than May 15, 2017. Requests for deadline extensions are subject to the approval of the Round Lake Area Park District.
4. Awarded applicants agree to use phosphorus free fertilizers.
5. All invoices and receipts must be turned in and a final site visit performed in order for the applicant to be reimbursed.
6. Applicants agree to have photos of the restoration taken to be used in promotional purposes for the Round Lake Area Park District and the Huebner Fishery Management Foundation.
7. Applicants are responsible to make sure that all necessary permits are obtained before work is done.
8. **Applications must be returned to the Round Lake Area Park District, Attn: Huebner Shoreline Grant, 814 Hart Road, Round Lake, IL by March 1, 2017.**
